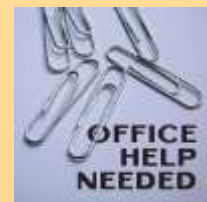

The Give+ Program is operated by Vanco Services, LLC, an industry leader in electronic payment solutions. We have worked with Vanco for several years and are excited to expand our current Simply Giving program. Below you will find step-by-step instructions on how this new Give+ option works.

- 1) Visit our website (www.BeaverValleyLutheran.org) and look for the **Simply Giving/Online Giving** button which is located right next to the Sermons Online button. Click to launch the eGiving portal.
- 2) To give a one-time gift to the church, simply complete the form on the page to initiate an electronic debit from your checking or savings account.

Select "General Fund" from the **Select Fund** drop-down box, leave the frequency at "One Time" and enter the amount (in whole dollar amounts). Select the **Add Donation** button and the details of the transaction will display on the screen.

If everything looks correct, select **Next**.

Active generations will exchange the red and blue bags each day with a new list. Keep track of your time and mileage each day. Sign off each day with your information and return list and bags to the Splitrock Tower Apts.

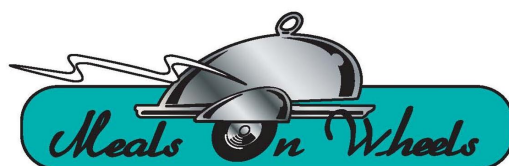

It is a very rewarding experience and families with children may want to consider making it a family service project before school starts. It is easier to have two people each day, one to drive and the other delivers the meal to the client.

WELCA – June 2021

The women of the church have been meeting under the theme, “coming back to life.”

A combined group of over thirty women of the church have attended at least one of two retreats this spring. The goal has been to set aside “business as usual” and talk deeply about the need for new, spiritual beginnings for all the generations of the church. Through this process we have discerned that women of every generation struggle with the issue of finding the time required to deepen their faith. A clear desire of adults (not just women) across the church is to broaden their knowledge of the bible and of the basics of faith upon which we live our lives in service to neighbor.

In the coming months, concrete steps will be taken to put together a day-long women’s spiritual retreat (winter of 2022) as well as begin to develop small group commitments to study and pray and serve together in new ways.

As a response to this retreat and the prior encouragement of the church council, Pastor Greg has committed himself to the creation of bible study materials that will be packaged so that they can be used in a variety of settings by women and men of every age. In addition to that personal task, Pastor Greg will also begin to gather good study materials from a variety of trusted sources to begin to build a library of possible offerings for the coming year.

A combination of women and men will form a sweet corn feed committee and get started with plans for this year’s August 15th celebration.

Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes:

MMSC: Motion to approve April Minutes was made by Dave Schnabel and seconded by Rick Bonander
Motion carried.

Approval of Treasurer's Report:

Last months giving's was up by a little, we did not have any extra expenses. We are overall still behind on expenses over income.

MMSC: Motion to approve the April Treasurers report made by Linda Wingate and seconded by Sue Johannsen.

Motion carried. Treasurer's report is available in the Church Office.

Business:

Opening our doors, Greg read the letter from the CDC guidelines, Discussion was had about going forward and was decided to make signs to make mask optional and open all pews the first Sunday in June. We still want to be careful and respect and welcome everyone that enters the building.

Mid-summer discussion, Michael talked about the Jazz and Blues Society helped to put him in contact with the Hegg Brothers. They are willing to come and play for our Saturday evening, June 26th mid-summer picnic. Then a 7:00 p.m. concert with Dedication of the Pavilion at the close. . Council decided to move forward with the Hegg Brothers. Their fee is \$1,000.

Greg talked about getting the Dakota Road band for the Evening of August 22nd. He wrote a grant proposal that would help fund this second concert out in our Pavilion. Stacy asked about money to be used and possibly using the Alliance rebate money. Also talked about bathrooms and forming a committee to help guide Pavilion use for things like concerts. Seen as part of our Evangelism, "all are welcome" efforts as we re-open.

Summer schedule, Pavilion worship will start on the 19th. Greg will be gone for part of three weeks in July. We will have other pastors fill in, currently they are getting \$50 for outdoor worship services, Greg would like to raise that to \$75.
