## Optimism is for the Faithful

It's really o.k. if this is a prayer: "Dear God, help me see the good in the day and not give up on a better tomorrow." Optimism is what we are afforded as children of God. Not only "afforded," but optimism is the expected posture with which we live our

every day, no matter how bleak the world around us might be.

Deitrich Bonhoeffer helps us with this conversation. From prison he wrote,

"It is wiser to be pessimistic; it is a way of avoiding disappointment and ridicule, and so wise people condemn optimism.

The essence of optimism is not its view of the present, but the fact that it is the inspiration of life and hope when others give in; it enables a man to hold his head high when everything seems to be going wrong; it gives him strength to sustain reverses and yet claim the future for himself instead of abandoning it to his opponent.

The optimism that is will for the future should never be despised, even if it is proved wrong a hundred times; it is health and vitality....

## It may be that the day of judgement will dawn tomorrow; in that case, we shall gladly stop working for a better future. But not before." (from <u>Letters and Prayers from Prison</u>, p. 15)

As we enter a pivotally important year for our congregation, (*our annual meeting was a wonderful chance for us to turn forward, anticipating new beginnings for God's work among and through us as we emerge from pandemic just exactly as we have always been into a world that will never quite be the same)*, I am optimistic. I have heard from you and you heard from me that we will not stop "working for a better future", trusting that that spiritual posture will keep us alive and working together in the sharing of the Good News.

In the coming year, I expect that our congregation can be a part of finding new ways to reach out to those who crave a good word. Perhaps it will be a live streamed hour of worship that God uses to help a child along. Perhaps it will be that visitor who finds the time and dares enter our building who discovers that "where two or three gather in my name" really is the gospel itself. Maybe it will be a Senior High student that sits around a Montana campfire and visits with a college-aged counselor about a future that can be embraced. Maybe it will be in what God does in and through the sacraments of the church that fans the flames of Beaver Valley's continued growth.

Wherever we in 2022 see signs of life, let us give thanks. And when unrest sits at our doorstep, let us pray for an optimism that God promises to sustain. For, as Bonhoeffer helps the faithful understand, it is optimism that creates beauty, not the other way around.

Beaver Valley Lutheran Church delivers hot, nutritious meals to the Brandon community shut-ins for the months of March and August. During these months, we are in need of people to help deliver meals. The meals are picked up at the Splitrock Tower Apartments 1100

Teakwood Street at 11:50 am. The red and blue bags are inside the front door. When picking up, double check the list to make sure there are no new additions for the Splitrock apartments, then deliver the meals in the apartments and continue with the city deliveries.

Active generations will exchange the red and blue bags each day with a new list. Keep track of your time and mileage each day. Sign off each day with your information and return list and bags to the Splitrock Tower Apts.

There is a list of names and addresses, with directions on how to get to the residence within the city and Bethany Meadows.

Depending upon the number of clients receiving meals, it takes approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour to deliver.

It is a very rewarding experience. Delivering is easier with two people each day, one to drive and the other delivers the meal to the client. You are needed for this service!

Please sign up on the MOW calendar by the church office which will be posted in February. If you have not driven or delivered before, you need to fill out a volunteer application with your personal information. This form is necessary for liability for Active Generations.
