“*At The End of the Day*”

One of the lasting memories I will have of my mother, whose death and burial are still very much fresh in my mind at the writing of this article, is of her saying to her full-speed-ahead son, “*Greg, the day is over. It’s time to get some rest.*” I don’t know if I listened to her at bedtime any better than I did during the day, but I, now as an adult, greatly appreciate the reminder that we are human and there is a limit to what any day’s work is expected to hold--work or worry, or play, or simply busyness that wants us to just keep *going*.

This Lent will be as most, good Lenten observances I can remember have been, an attempt to slow down and be together for simple, end-of-the-day worship that invites God to take some of the load and carry it for us.

Maybe this year as much as any year I can think of in my three and half decades of ministry we need to help each other turn our worries over at the end of the day. Great teachers of faith will be the devotion writers this Lent. From this preacher shared readings with brief reflections based on what we just heard read with hopefully a take home thought purposeful for evening prayer. We will sing three, wonderful, end of the day songs for most of Lent. We want to learn them by heart. We will hear God speak to us throughout Lent as we read responsively each night from Psalm 139. We will ask God to help us let go of all that our busy minds are working on and go home and make sure the house is quiet, trusting God with our nights.

I pray that we will be in good numbers for **March 2, 6:30 p.m., Ash Wednesday worship**. This will be sanctuary worship with Holy Communion and the imposition of ashes in one space. After this important start to our 40 days of preparation for Easter (that’s what Lent is all about after all), we will gather downstairs for evening fellowship. On this first night a selection of cakes from which to choose (and always the makings for peanut butter and jelly sandwiches for the kids who just want something different!).

The rest of Lent we will all gather around tables in the fellowship hall for 6:30 p.m. worship and then around 7:00 p.m. we will enjoy different deserts and de-caf coffee for these remaining five Wednesdays. (see full page article in this Tidings). Thank you in advance for your willingness to help me stand with you as we turn our worry over to the one who keeps charge of each us through the night.
