I am certain, that if every active member of our congregation feels that they are a part of the prayerful visioning that is soon upon us (into September we will gather often to offer ideas and listen) that others will see our good intentions and will draw closer to the Good News.

So, in real, concrete terms what is Jesus saying to Beaver Valley Lutheran members when he timelessly says to all disciples, "let your light shine?" God is certainly calling us yet (as we live in transition) to be faithful in our service to this world. We will continue into the coming months to:

- give to 6% to ministries of the church out beyond our own congregation.
- commit as completely as ever to the teaching of the Jesus story to our children (Jesus teaches us how to stay loving and strong in a wild world). Please read the article in this <u>Tidings</u> about our mini-VBS on the 28th.
- Welcome the many people who drive by our gathering...to invite them to join with us on the 21st at Boom Funeral Home Chapel.
- To pray for our community, the sick and those struggling, as we trust that we can be Christ in this world.

I thank you all for your faithful support of the work of this congregation. To surpass previous years offering totals even while we are challenged in the early weeks to re-establish our ministry footprint is remarkable. I pray that God will continue to bless the daily work of our congregation even as we ask God to bless the coming years with the decisions we make regarding the remake of our building. "New Beginnings" Rebuild Report

This column will be (in addition to mid-week email updates throughout the weeks of the year+ ahead) a regular feature in the Tidings. It will be written by a member of the Executive Board of the council and will be our best effort to share—across the entire membership—the latest information about what's going on with our Rebuild, upcoming activities that we may be able to host at the old site even as construction continues, etc.

On Wednesday evening, July 27, our first efforts at getting five committees organized with a clear "lines-of-communication" flow chart happened. Chairpersons for each committee will be in charge of their committees' work and will regularly pass that information on to the executive board that will then get the word out to all.

What can be reported so far is:

- An initial payment of money has been received from our insurer, Cincinnati Ins. Company. This deposit will allow us to begin paying bills. This deposited amount of \$1,200,000 is not the full settlement amount. That will be determined over the course of the build as contractor and insurer agree upon real costs pertaining to each facet of the rebuild.
- The council voted to hire Gil Haugen construction company to be the contractor. A letter of intent was signed on July 26th.
- Gil Haugen is now in the process of receiving bids from construction companies that will help clear the debris from inside the walls which we are asked (by Cincinnati) to save if possible. No time frame yet for the start to cleanup work.
- The first, congregation-wide "visioning" session will be scheduled for August 21st. We will worship, have a shortened coffee hour and get into the business of visioning what our ministry needs will be in our coming years. Watch your mid-week emails and Sunday bulletins and broadcasts for details.
