(If we remember to worship together and serve outside our congregation, we will be o.k.)

By now, the shock of the May 30<sup>th</sup> storm, with its subsequent and continuing disruption of our daily patterns, is diminished. The reality of a "long haul" has directed our planning and work of the past four months. We were told just days ago that actual construction will likely begin next spring. We are getting the office configured in such a way that we can do what we need to do quite like before (as least most of the time!) Leadership has come together nicely with defined responsibilities involving a good cross section of the congregation. We are getting used to the George Boom Chapel as our Sunday morning worship venue just as we are bringing the Beaver Valley sanctuary back into play on Wednesdays at 6:30 p.m. for chapel worship. We are here and there, but we are beginning to realize that our work is still with us and important.

How are you doing with all of this? People are kind to ask me that question and so now, in this early fall afternoon I ask you, the reader, the same thing: How are you doing with all the time and places and configurations that make us Beaver Valley for the time being? I pray, that you are doing well and that you have the same sense I have about the next couple of years: we are just going to settle in now and keep growing our ministry.

What I am amazed with in all of this is that we, centered in the hearing and study of the word, have all that we need to not just survive, but really thrive no matter how foreign our temporary surroundings might be. I am convinced that as we give our offerings to God's work in and through this congregation of ours that we do, as we always have, prosper God's work on earth. I know this much about these days: if we commit to worshipping together each week and involving ourselves in the work of serving others, Beaver Valley Lutheran Church will reenter our new building alive and well!

In this October newsletter, please take the time to read about and be inspired to be involved in the life of our congregation: some pumpkin painting fun for children as we celebrate the harvest; members joining prisoners for worship at the SD State Penitentiary; Confirmation students learning and some, our 9<sup>th</sup> graders, saying "yes" to their baptisms; Men gathering for a morning devotion and some conversation in Larry and Ardell's corn crib; Senior High youth taking real ownership of their young-adult faith walk; etc. Yes, it's what we have done and will keep doing and more as we settle in now for our time in temporary places while the rebuild of our ministry site continues.

Yes, there are lots of unknowns during this time. But one thing we know for sure, we are kept and our "going out and our coming back in" in life are in the hands of the one who goes with us through the dangerous hills of life. (Read Psalm 121 for your end of the day)

## "New Beginnings" Rebuild Report

To Members of our congregation,

On Monday, September 26, six of us from the rebuild team (Myself, Dave Schnabel, Larry Johnson, Dan Steen, Kevin Backer, and Pastor Greg) met with Gil Haugen's project manager, Todd. First, we thanked him for his crew's work at removing debris. Wow, I can't describe how happy we are that work has now begun! The crane (cover photo) is piling up the debris outside on the parking lot. It is being hauled away.

Todd also took some brick with him to start matching up for construction.

We also talked about getting the water shut off in the fellowship hall. Also about getting gas back in our sanctuary for heat this winter. We were again reminded that all of the heating and cooling infrastructure in the damaged building will be removed. As well, all of the ceilings and light fixtures are condemned and need to be hauled away.

We also talked about capping the open walls for winter.

Now that the debris is almost entirely removed, a structural engineer and architect will come in to evaluate the soundness of the building and possibilities for new design.

In talking with Todd, the need to do our visioning and then "get real" with ideas to ask the architect is right now! So, get involved with the visioning we are doing (see calendar) and know that more congregation wide visiting is yet to come.

### October 2<sup>nd</sup>, Sundays, 9:30 a.m.—Worship at Boom Chapel


