"God calls us to the Tabernacle"

We find the first biblical mention of a "tabernacle" in the book of Exodus. In this historic chapter of Israel's history, Moses is leading God's people in the wandering-wilderness for some forty years--God's people on the run and waiting to get back to a home. And while waiting to get home, God was worshipped in a temporary sanctuary called a tabernacle…a carefully built, tent-like complex that was often moved and was the place where the people would gather so that they could stay alive in the faith. The Bible Dictionary provides further context:

"Part of the significance of the tabernacle is seen in the reading from the book of Exodus. The book contains three segments: chapters 1-15, the account of the deliverance from Egypt, culminating in the Red Sea crossing; chapters 16-24, the account of the journey to Sinai, culminating in the sealing of the covenant; and chapters 25-40, the account of the building of the tabernacle, culminating in its being filled with the glory of God. This literary structure shows that the ultimate need of the people was not for deliverance from physical oppression or from theological darkness, but from alienation from God."

We, too, are offered the blessings of a tabernacle! Beaver Valley is a congregation of people in a bit of trouble, wandering in some ways for sure (hopefully not forty years!), waiting to get back to a permanent home. We, like the Old Testament people of God, are stressed to be living in temporary quarters and always needing to improvise and keep working at ways to have a good cup of coffee together! Let us not underestimate our need to be together in Jesus' name! The danger we face as a congregation is not that we don't have a building (physical oppression) but that we might become alienated from God if we don't each week gather to stay alive.

This month of February, we have a chance to blow the rams horn and call every member of our congregation to gather in the tabernacle. Beginning on **Ash Wednesday**, **February 22**, the members of Beaver Valley will wander their way to the Brandon Holiday Inn Express where we will celebrate being God's people: a meal shared and then "ashes on the head" Holy Communion worship. Yes, again the tabernacle is being moved! We have no other place than a new place if all of our people are going to be able to worship together (Boom Chapel is not available nor our old sanctuary for congregation-wide gathering).

I pray that we will be inspired by this chance to be Beaver Valley in a new place. Calls will go out. A Signup Genius is ready for online reservations (link provided in mid-week emails on our website). We will need to know how many meals are to be prepared and how many round tables will be set up for our sacred, Ash Wednesday evening worship. The theme for this Lent is a simple one: "A Life of Faith." From God's claim upon each of us in the waters of baptism all the way to the realization that we, in full maturity, are the Sent Ones....the one's who will not give up on this complicated world.

Please read about this incredibly busy month for our congregation in this newsletter. Youth writing parts of worship; our February 12th "All Youth Benefit" auction and bake sale; families sitting at round tables taking in the "A Life of Faith" videos each Lenten night; careful, prayed over work getting ready for the rebuild of our church all the while the congregation stays alive, together in our tent.

"New Beginnings" Rebuild Report

To Members of our congregation,

We are making good progress in deciding what changes we would hope to make as we move this rebuild conversation along. In the first week in December more planning was moved along with Gil Haugen. For the first time, we met with the architect from Gil Haugen who was fully briefed on ideas that our congregation has come up with for doing some things new in the rebuild.

Most recently, on Tuesday January 24, Pastor Greg and I met with our project foreman, Todd, to receive from him project drawings (48 pages) and a specification manual. These design drawings give detail to what the straight rebuild would require as well as shows what our seven alternate ideas (that came from our visioning process this past fall) would look like. We are still waiting to get final estimates on what each of these alternate changes will cost. We were told that before our February 22, Ash Wednesday, capital campaign begins, we will have a real idea about what our financial goals will be to rebuild our church the way we think it needs to be.

Thanks to every member for your interest and involvement in this historic time. We pray that God will help us do what is right and that our future will prosper in our new building. Thank you for your inputs at the annual meeting, Jan 29th. Thank you for being prayerful about the future of our church especially during the season of Lent when we will all join in making financial commitments that will fund our new building.



Dur-ing these months, we are in need of volunteers to help deliver meals. The meals are picked up at the Splitrock Apartments 1100 Teak-wood Street at 11:50 am. The red and blue bags are inside the front door. When

picking up, double check the list to make sure there are no new additions for the Splitrock apartments, then deliver the meals in the apartments and continue with the city deliveries.

Active generations will exchange the red and blue bags each day with a new list. Keep track of your time and mileage each day. Sign off each day with your information and return the list and bags to the Splitrock Apts.

Please call me if you have questions anytime during delivery.

There is a list of names and addresses, with direc-tions on how to get to the residence within the city and Bethany Meadows.

Depend-ing upon the num-ber of clients receiv-ing meals, it takes approx-i-mately 1 hour and a half to deliver.

It is a very reward-ing expe-ri-ence. Delivering is easier with two people each day, one to drive and the other delivers the meal to the client. You are needed for this service!
