A Life of Faith *(becoming mature followers of Jesus in community)*

During the month of March, Beaver Valley Lutheran members will pray over our community of faith—what it has meant in the past 150 years to so many, and what our gathering will mean into the future to which we are called.

As this short note is coming together we are fresh off of our special, February 26th meeting of the congregation whereupon we decided how we would proceed with our envisioned plans for the rebuild of our church campus. The optimism we already have about our ability to pay for the changes we would like to make to the building design that was destroyed by the tornado, reflect a real desire to be hospitable and creative in our refreshed space. All the generations' needs (from a better elevator for those with ambulatory needs all the way to more open, flexible space for teaching our young) reflect the fact that we need a building that allows for the growth of faith *throughout the seasons of life*. We are together to worship, learn, support on another with cups of coffee in hand and plan for the work that is ahead. No person is alive without community reminds Jesus. (Matthew 18:20, “where two or three gather in my name, there I am with them.”)

“A Life of Faith” is a theme both for our Lenten worshipping at the Holiday Inn (starting on March 1, because of our Ash Wednesday storm) but also each of our homes as we pray over our financial, rebuild commitments. The “A Life of Faith” campaign materials will be available for your picking up at Lenten worship on March 1 (5:30 meal, 6:45 p.m. worship) or will be received via the mail with packets post-marked March 2. Know that every home that prayerfully considers how to support the rebuilding of our church will be joined by others doing the same. It is together that we find our strength. Even if you cannot give a second mile, special gift to help pay for the rebuild, your earnest prayers for God’s blessings upon a place where we work on our lives of faith will be meaningful and part of the inspiration that leads to what we become.

I am thankful for what will take place this month of March: many members gathering to share a meal and then worship on Lenten Wednesdays at the Holiday Inn Express, considering how it is God helps us along life’s way; and financial commitments being added together at the end of March (we ask that your response card be turned back in by March 29th—either in the box provided at Sunday (Boom Chapel) and Wednesday (Holiday Inn) worship venues or by mailing them to BVLC, Box 128, Brandon, SD, 57005).

It is what God has done in the past and will do among us in the future that makes this month of March “set-aside” with sacred focus.

“New Beginnings” Rebuild Report

To Members of our congregation,

It really feels like we are turning a corner and now know how it is we are going move forward with our rebuild.

On Friday, February 17th, David Vanden Hull, David Schnabel, Pastor Greg and I met with Todd Benda from Gil Haugen. At this meeting we were presented with the estimates of cost associated with each alternative to the rebuild that we had asked them to bid out. These alternatives came from our visioning/talking we did last fall.

These numbers allowed us to then call a special meeting of the congregation which was just held on Sunday, February 26th, at 10:45 a.m. At this meeting we discussed the scope of the project and then voted to officially sign paperwork that will give permission to Gil Haugen to begin ordering supplies/materials as needed to complete our rebuild.

The work is not done for our members! We will be serving the workers throughout the build. We will keep gathering to form groups that will stay focused upon specific design inputs that will be needed (i.e., a nice cross section of members to work on kitchen design, color scheme throughout the building, member volunteerism when appropriate and approved by Gil Haugen, etc.)

Thank you to all who have and will continue to keep our Beaver Valley in your prayers. Thank you for prayerfully considering a gift to help pay off the expenses we have approved to build a new ministry site that will serve us well into the future.
