He is Risen! (And we are too!)

The month of May is a month spent continuing to hear the Good News stories of Jesus risen—first to Mary, then to two men walking on the road to Emaus, then to eleven disciples behind closed doors, then to a doubting Thomas, then to hundreds more before his end of May ascension and then, finally, the real birth of the church: Pentecost. All of this a triumphant remembrance that death won't win in the coming four Sundays.

Let's build on this. Not only is Jesus risen to history, so too are *we* risen within our own histories. This is the power of the gospel for each and for we together: that as Jesus was risen, we too are risen to new beginnings throughout our days. It's what forgiveness does. It's what the interceding Holy Spirit promises to do in and among us.

As I write this newsletter a "rising up" is happening! If you haven't driven by the church site in the past couple of weeks, you might want to do that. The rebuild has physically begun. Our insurance company fully approved the rebuild of our former structure and we as a congregation have decided to make six changes to rebuild designs based upon our visioning last fall (by the way, it was a great sign of health to have over 100 different members participate in our layers of visioning which resulted in the changes we, on February 26th, approved by vote and committed to in spirit). The Pentecost church is people who pray over their work and trust in God's guidance.

As you read further into this May newsletter, you will see that the need for continued trust in God's presence among us to help us find our way to a completed rising of our future ministry home. The structural design work is done. The work of putting the "finishes" to the design are not.

Committees have been formed for the primary purpose of making sure that many within the congregation who have particular ideas about how to best finish, let's say, the fellowship hall, will know who it is serving on which committee to go to with their ideas. Last Fall, we dreamt about what changes to the old footprint would be helpful for future ministry. This spring, we will again broadly listen and then move to decisions about color and style and interior movement and purpose. Your presence at the special meeting of the congregation on Sunday May 7th at 10:45 a.m. at Boom Chapel in Brandon will be a gift to our congregation. (Another vote required to address committee suggested modification to our south entrance will be the purpose of this May 7th meeting).

My daily pastoral prayer is that we will listen well and lovingly to one another, trusting that when we walk through the doors of Beaver Valley Lutheran and get back to ministry in our own church "home," that we will be of good spirit and thankful for how God held us together and inspired us to be community in our wilderness wandering of more than a year and half. I am thankful to be able to invite trust in God's Pentecost, birthing spirit. I am thankful that in all seasons, the Church celebrates Jesus risen as our own story.


