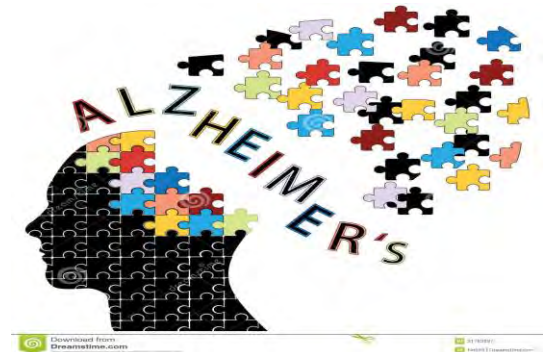
discussing, as a congregation, the next steps moving forward to "decorating" the church. This is the time for your voices to be heard. Please put this on your calendar and plan to be in attendance.

Donations of money to defray food costs and storage trays are welcomed!



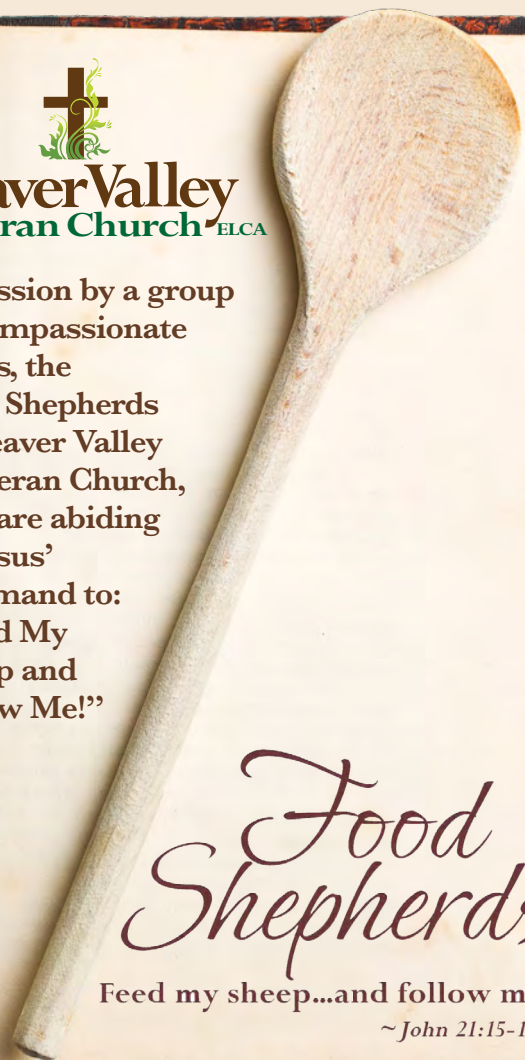

Cyber Crimes are on the rise! Here are some helpful tips to keep you safe

We have been having phishing emails going around our church family. Below are some tips that we received from Alliance Communications to help you determine whether an email or text could be phishing. As always, if you are unsure who the email is from, or even if the sender has a familiar name, but their email address looks different, don't open or click on anything in the email.



HOW TO STAY SAFE ONLINE

When it comes to cybersecurity, avoid pressure tactics, time-sensitive offers, deals too good to be true, or requests for personal information with the following tips:

- Check that the website you're purchasing from is secure by looking for a padlock icon and 'https://' in the URL (the "s" in "https" stands for secure).
- If shopping on an unknown site, search for ratings and reviews of the company, or check the Better Business Bureau.
- Check the "from" email addresses for inconsistencies and review company emails for poor or unusual grammar or incorrect logos.
- Be cautious of emails that ask for personal information or links that direct you to update your account details.
- Scammers may trick you into sharing a verification code "to verify that you are not a scammer". Never give a verification code to someone else, as scammers can use it to gain access to your accounts.

If a deal seems too good to be true, it most likely is! Stop and think before clicking on links or giving out personal information online or via email, text, or phone calls.

PHISHING AND PHONES

Studies show that 80% of phishing attacks target mobile devices. If a text message or phone call prompts you to click a link or take action, proceed cautiously. Many mobile scams try to elicit a panic response and often relate to unblocking a credit card or account, a package delivery, or wiring money. This also includes fake messages from companies or political candidates asking for donations.



EFFICIENT WAYS TO SECURE YOUR DATA

Studies show that fatigue and burnout significantly increase the likelihood of cybersecurity threats. From mismanaged passwords to overlooked phishing emails, here's how you can enhance your cybersecurity practices:

- Password Managers: Store and autofill unique and complex passwords for each account login without memorizing, resetting, or re-using the same password.
- Cyber Training: Incorporate short bursts of cybersecurity training into your schedule to better defend against cyber fatigue and enhance your response to threats.
- Multi-Factor Authentication: Rather than just asking for a username and password, multi-step account login processes require users to complete an additional step, such as entering a one-time passcode.
