




#### Operation Restoration VBS - Wednesday July 26th at 6:00pm




#### **Volunteer Opportunity!!!**

First deliver the meals within the Splitrock Apts, load your vehicle and deliver the rest of the meals in Brandon. Depending upon the number of people receiving meals, it takes approximately one hour to deliver. Last March twenty-one meals were on the list.
