Gentle God, Gentle People

"He will feed his flock like a shepherd, He will gather his lambs in his arm, he will carry them in his bosom, and will gently lead those who have their young." (Is. 40:11 AMP)

This world is angry and unsettled and so many of the headlines are stolen by all things that are harsh and unkind: wars, political polarization and its unforgiving lexicon, hatreds of most any kind. For followers of Jesus Christ our days must be different.

The prophets foretold of God sending a leader for God's people who would not be arrogant and harsh, but instead, would be perfectly gentle in dealing with God's hurting people. Old and New Testament alike describe this God coming: a "shoot from Jesse's stem", our "Prince of Peace," the Son of God, this Son of Man, as one who could have chosen to be served, but didn't, having "emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant" (Philippians 2:5-11, the famous Christ Hymn).

That this servant God came to earth at Christmas in a most gentle way, really becomes our calling--to live as gentle people--as we take seriously our baptismal callings to be "little Christs" in this often harsh world. Famous American author and storyteller, Garrison Keillor invites us to consider the beauty and the steady power that living a gentle life will have:

"What keeps our faith cheerful is the extreme persistence of gentleness and humor. Gentleness is everywhere in daily life, a sign that faith rules through ordinary things: through cooking and small talk, through storytelling, making love, fishing, tending animals and sweet corn and flowers, through sports, music and books and raising kids—all the places where the gravy soaks in and grace shines through. Even in a time of elephantine vanity and greed, one never has to look far to see the campfires of gentle people. Lacking any other purpose in life, it would be good enough to live for their sake."

Throughout these December days, may the life of our congregation be a testament to living in Jesus' name: Sunday school Christmas programs, a Christmas cantata led by almost thirty voices, gifts gathered by our youth to give away in the cold days of January for those most in need, Candlelight worship services with flames dancing in the dark--reminding us that angry darkness will not defeat the smallest campfire burning.

Important Message from our Church Treasurer

For those of you who might not know me my name is Darcie Johnson, your church treasurer. There has been a lot going on in the past almost 2 years since I took over the position. During the month of November, the stewardship committee has been presenting with you different topics, and discussing the increase that we will see in the budget in 2024. I'm hoping to help provide you all with a little bit more information and detail into those specific items.

2024 Budget Concerns: 15% Budget Increase

- 1. Pastor Compensation Package
 - 1. For the past 10 years Pastor Greg has been taking a salary reduction for his offering contribution this has been directly removed from the Pastor compensation on the budget.
 - 1. We have adjusted to 2024 Budget to reflect Pastor salary that meets Synod Guidelines (no reduction with an offering contribution)
 - 1. I'm not sure if members knew this had been occurring in the past 10 years, but as a church we need to see the impact of this on our budget
- 2. Office Staff Increase to 32 hours weekly Estimated \$13,000 increase
 - 1. 10 hours Remote (Kari)
 - 2. 22 Hours In House Admin (5.5/day)
 - 1. Why are we looking at doing this?
 - 1. Kari has been an excellent employee, we will need her to help train the new office staff. Kari has knowledge of certain areas (website, Shepards staff) that is extremely valuable. This will allow us to have 2 people that are trained and able to assist when needed. Giving the church more stability in the office staff
 - 2.In House administration is a necessity as well. Hours would be from 9 am to 3 pm Monday thru Thursday tentatively. Kari & Pastor Greg would help train this individual.
- 3. Insurance
 - 1. 30% Increase from 2023 to 2024
 - 1. Why? There are a couple of different reasons
 - 1. Increase in property value when the tornado hit, we had a coverage of \$3.2 million. With the damage to just one side of our building our insurance claim will be close to \$2.5 when all said and done. When everything is complete, we will give a full detail of the figures.
 - 1. Our new property value is \$5.9 million
 - 2. Insurance calculations are very difficult and I won't even try to tell you I full understand the. But most of us have seen insurance increases in our business and property over the past 12-18 months. The church is seeing the same thing. My hope is that we will see this level out, and next year we will see a minimal increase. Unfortunately, I can't guarantee that but with our property value at a more reasonable rate, if everything stays steady I would anticipate that is what would happen.
- 4. Budget Standards
 - 1. We are kind of in the same situation as we were last year, with getting back into the building. We've kept the majority of the lines items the exact same, or reduced some because insurance money will be helping replace some of the items.
 - 2. New Copier we do have that on order, accurate #'s will be in the budget
 - 3. Phone/Internet we will be getting new figures from Alliance and have that accurate in the budget

Treasurer's Summary:





Parish Life Group (PLG) "JOY"




