

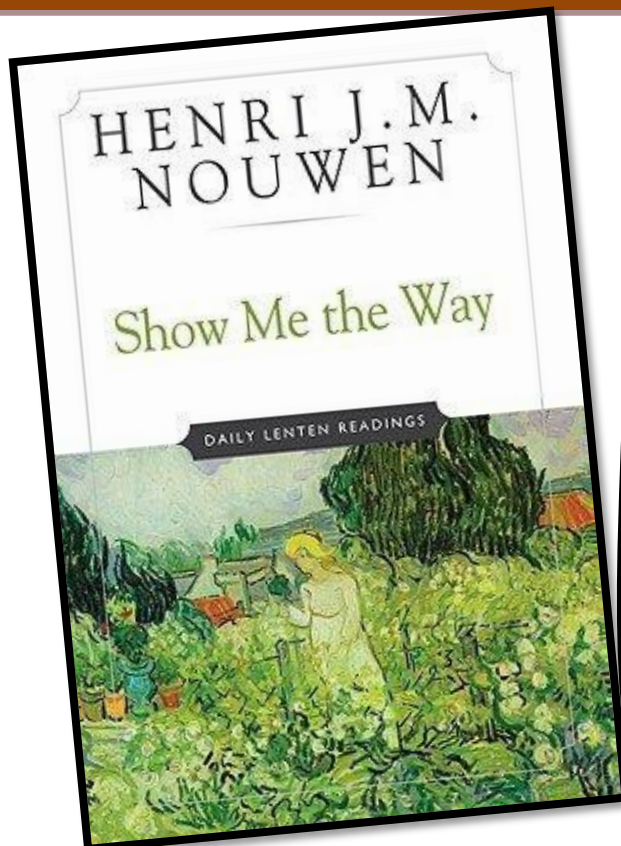

“Show Me the Way”

There is something wonderful about being in a place and knowing that you simply need to ask for help in getting to where you need to go. There is kind of an awakening at that moment—I need to have someone else who knows more than I do come and help get me on my way. For me, this happens often: a broken garage door, I call the guy (in my most recent case) who knows how to put up a new tension spring and get the garage door opened again in time for church on Sunday; a weird noise in the transmission, needing the expertise of a brilliant transmission specialist; my cell phone acting up again, a call to any of my kids or grandkids who can help me!

Now, the biggest moment in my ministry: how to set the table for the rebirth of the congregation. A pastor’s job, after all, is to lead the congregation in worship and service—that’s at the heart of my calling to carry out Word and Sacrament ministry. My ordination certificate says so. But, this time, at this moment, I can wonderfully confess that I think it’s time we all (your pastor first among you) confess that we need to ask for help to get to where we need to go.

This Lent, let us stop and admit our need for guidance and ask God to grant us vision to know both how to keep the wonderful pieces of our ministry that made us a beautiful congregation in the past and to see as clearly as we can the most urgent needs that our members and strangers will have in the future. God needs to show us the way into what’s next as we get ready to launch into what’s new.

Beginning on Ash Wednesday night, February 14th and carrying on through the remaining five Wednesday nights of Lent, we will use Fr. Henri Nouwen’s classic devotional, Show Me the Way, as the basis for our Lenten meditations. At the center of each night will be the call across our membership to be prayerful in our approach to what is to come—not quick-to-find answers as much as asking God to help us gain a sense of what will bring people to this God house called Beaver Valley. What needs are most urgent among us? What are our best attributes not to be wasted? What do our young people need? What do they have to offer?

I invite members to order Show Me the Way for themselves (easy to find on line for well under \$10) If you want the office to order you a copy please email the office at office@beavervalleylutheran.org and Kari will get one sent and ready for you before Lent begins. I will use Nouwen’s devotional, visioning reflections as the beginning point for our simple chapel services. We will be invited to really pray and listen and be shaped by the One who knows what we don’t know: how to make all things new again.

I trust that we will arrive at Easter morning (March 31) having enjoyed each other’s company during Lent *and* the fact that we agreed that we really do need help in knowing what to do!

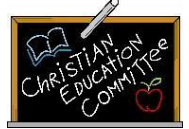

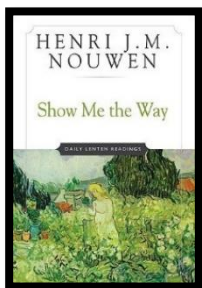


February 14th, Monday – Happy Valentine’s Day!!

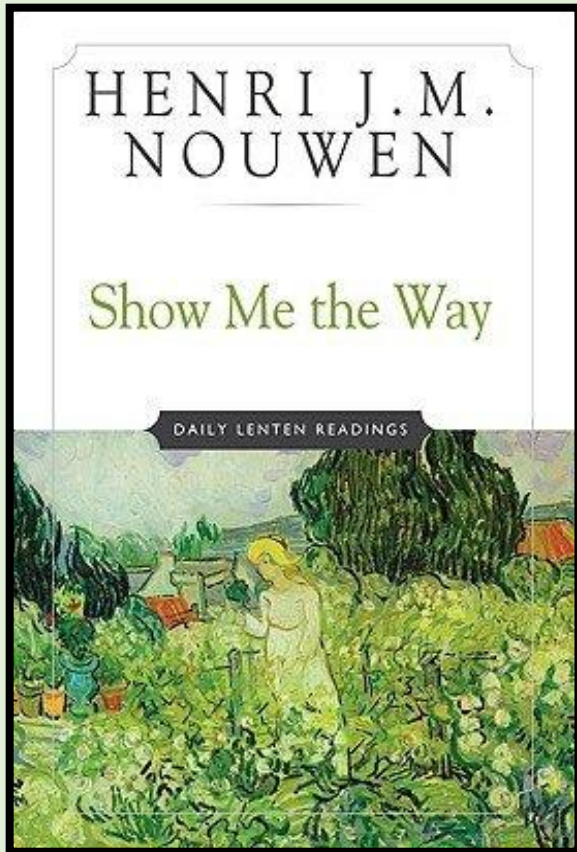

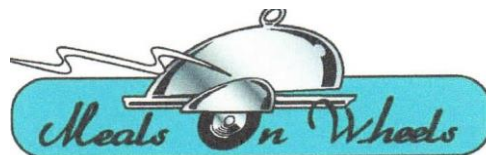
Depending upon the number of clients receiving meals, it takes approximately 1 hour for delivery. The client list and addresses are clear and accurate.
