Dedication

“You shall dwell in the land that I gave your fathers, and you shall be my people, I will be your God.” Ez. 36:28

On Sunday, April 7, our congregation and friends will gather to do our human best to dedicate our newly rebuilt spaces to the glory of God. But we can only do that in the spirit of Easter humility knowing that God’s dedication *to us* is the beginning and the end of our lives.

It will all begin with 9:30 a.m. worship. Already, it looks like the church will be full. Our children will call us into worship as they sing “Surely the Presence of the Lord is in this Place.” Then, a procession with an empty cross and members of our own church and guests and our Bishop Hagmaier leading us into worship. Then hymns and the choir and preaching and Holy Communion--all this ending with the singing of our very own hymn, “Hail, O Church” before we go out for a photo that will help us remember this day. Then a brief Dedication Program in our refurbished Fellowship Hall and then boxed lunches to really end things right!

Wow. That’s pulling out all of the stops! That’s a pretty great human dedication. Thank you in advance to the many of you who will come and pray over and be blessed by the mercies built into this day.

But, let’s be clear. This day is best understood not by emphasizing what we’re going to do, but to remember the dedication of God for God’s people. The prophet Ezekiel proclaimed God’s deep commitment to the people of Israel. God spoke through this prophet saying matter-of-factly, “You will be my people and I will be your God.” All of this as the restoration of Israel was a heaven come down act.

In a most perfect way, Jesus’ earthly ministry proclaimed God’s desire to resurrect—from every kind of trouble, even death itself—people and congregations alike.

April 7th will be a day to say thank you to many people, all in the spirit of saying thanks to God our Creator and Counselor. Having been sustained through our months of relocation, we will dedicate ourselves to the next chapter in Beaver Valley’s history knowing that God has already written the entire book.
