



You may have noticed the work happening in our "backyard" around the Pavilion area. With many thanks to Randy Nelson, dead and dying trees and stumps have been removed and site work has been done to ready our grounds for another part of the rebuild—THE PAVILION GARDENS.

The Committee would like to share with our church family the plans that are beginning to take shape to make our campus even more beautiful and inviting. There are steps we want to take to make certain this project is done correctly, while keeping costs as reasonable as possible.

We are connecting with nurseries in the area to create a master plan for The Gardens—a plan that can be implemented in sections, as funds allow.
