A HEARTFELT THANK YOU TO EVERYONE!! Our Phase One goal has been achieved! What a huge accomplishment!

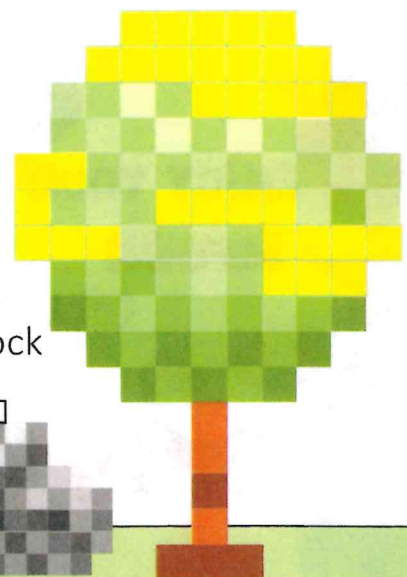

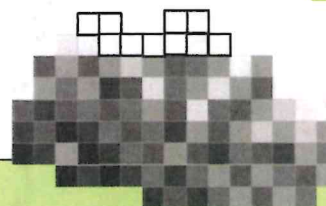
Prayer Garden Update

Phase 2 Rock



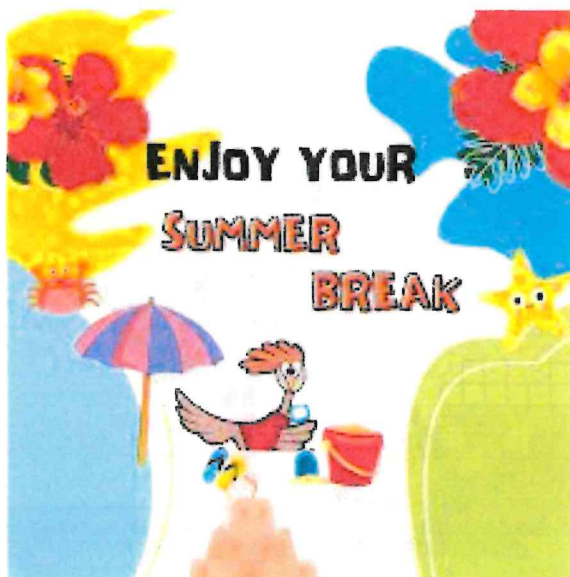
