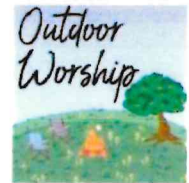

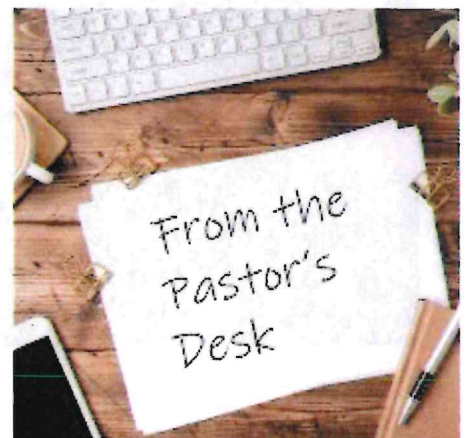

# Meet Our New Pastor

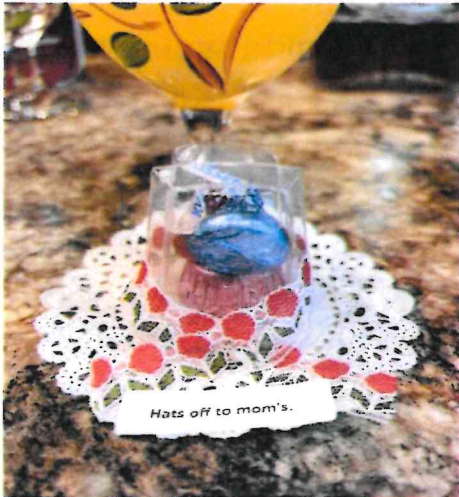

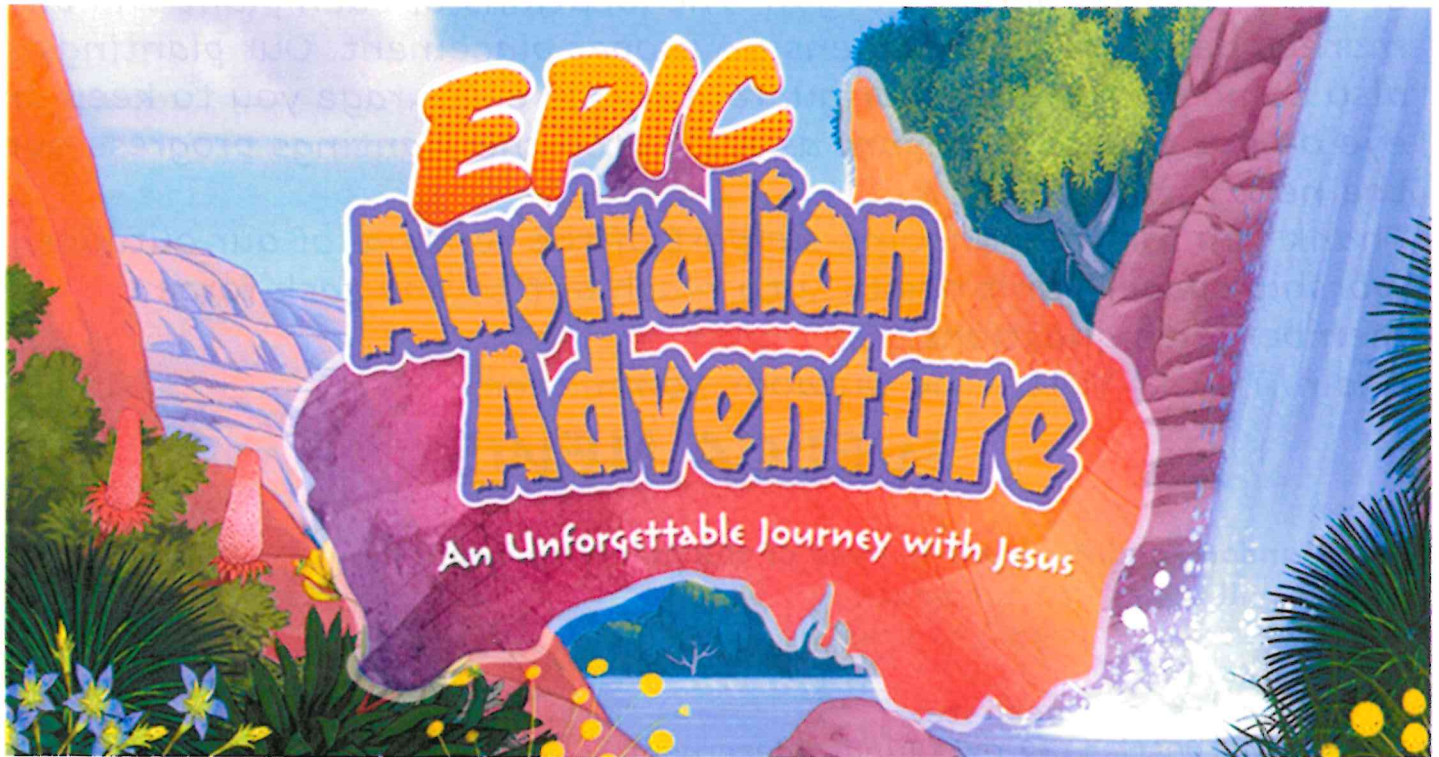
