How long has Pastor Josh been ordained?



Business:

- **BVLC Signage at 484**th **and 266**th We were contacted by Jacob Maras (605) 759-0585, Engineering Supervisor at Minnehaha County Highway, telling us that we need to move our signage back to the fence line as it is in the line of sight of traffic. Discussion was held with Doug Ode, and permission was given to move the signage next to the fence.
- HVAC operation and efficiency G&R Electric was contacted about switching the thermostats.
- Fellowship Hall The fans run continuously for quality air control and to draw out humidity, which helps to keep good air inside. The temp in the Fellowship Hall is on one computer which is very technology based, and only 2 people have the knowledge to control it.
- Office & Classrooms All are run by a thermostat and set to 73 degrees.
- Energy Efficiency It was discussed that we would contact a company to run an energy audit for us to see where we can conserve.
- **Playground Equipment** We received an email on June 3rd from Mandy Waldner (Church Member) regarding playground equipment. She works with the Bishop Dudley Hospitality House and has playground equipment that needs a new home. She is wondering if this is something that the church or preschool would be interested in.
 - On June 11th, Mandy sent the following email: I spoke to Madeline, who is the executive director. She has a call into Soukup Construction to see if they would be willing to remove the playground equipment for us. We've been told that the concrete is buried about 3 ft deep, and so it will need to be dug up and unassembled. At this time, I don't believe that we will be able to deliver the playground equipment and I'm not sure when we will be able to find someone to dig it out for us. As I get more information, I will pass that on. —A discussion was held, and a decision was made to decline the offer.
- **Library** The Children's Library corner will be placed in the alcove at the top of the stairs. Books will be ordered from the tornado fund.
- Pest Control Mice and Bats A motion was made to obtain a quote from Olson's Pest Technicians. Motion was made by Dan Feeken and seconded by Scott Hansel. Payment for this will come from the 2nd Day Fund.

- Website Looking for people to form a committee to decide what the new website should all contain. We will be obtaining bids for the new website. Motion to make the new website was made by Krista Hanson and Seconded by Amy Johnson.
- Rally Sunday Will be September 7th, 2025. Every committee will have a table for people to consider joining.
- **Midsommar** The New Horizon's Band held a concert in the fellowship. Ice Cream and Sweet treats were served after the concert. The Frog Dance and Maypole Dance were enjoyed by all.

Faith Community Nursing Program -


- Mary Oyos, the Department Manager the Avera's Diabetes Center, spoke on Type 2 Diabetes on May 18th. The presentation was attended by 24 people. Information on Type 2 Diabetes, diet, exercise and general tips was reviewed. The presentation lasted approximately 40 minutes.
- A meeting was held with Pastor Josh and Jacqui on additional ideas related to education for the general congregation. Discussions included Parenting classes, Babysitting Education, Canning, and correct car seat installation and use. These ideas were explored, and a speaker for each has been found. Plans would be promoted with our congregation and youth, as well as opening them to the general community. We will consider a Babysitting class in July, Canning in August, and Parenting and Car Seat education in the fall. I would suggest no charge, but that can be determined based on the cost of the speakers. I will know more in the next week or so.
- We will also offer a class on heart, blood pressure, and cholesterol in September. Speaker to be a congregational nurse. Additional blood pressure and blood sugar testing for interested individuals will be done on the last Sunday in June.
- Additionally, I met with Pastor Josh about his wishes related to Communion preparation and set up. The table in front of the altar will remain, set up is unchanged, and an additional server for bread will be added. Pastor Josh will be the second bread server. No changes as of yet to Chapel until Josh has had a chance to be involved. A reminder to change the altar colors will be sent.
