



In an effort to get the Tidings, our monthly newsletter, out in a timely manner, we need all articles submitted to the office by the  $20^{th}$  of the month.


If you are in charge of an event, please take pictures and submit a write-up regarding how it went. Everyone likes to see how active we have been.



- Additionally, I met with Pastor Josh about his wishes related to Communion preparation and set up. The table in front of the altar will remain, set up is unchanged, and an additional server for bread will be added. Pastor Josh will be the second bread server. No changes as of yet to Chapel until Josh has had a chance to be involved. A reminder to change the altar colors will be sent.
