




These are free class. Specific times and dates are listed there.

A Matter of Balance-Class Update

What causes more injury, a car crash or a fall in your tub? Easily, it could be a fall in your tub. Think about it. In your car, you are covered with roll bars, strapped in with a seat belt, and have airbags in front and beside you. In your tub, you're naked! No seat belts, roll bars, or air bags; it's just you and your unforgiving tub. By the time you figure that out, you are in big trouble and looking at the ceiling. I'm a healthy person and consider my age as my only risk factor for falls. I have a long-time fear of falling because I've seen some devastating injuries from falls, many of which could have been prevented. Full disclosure: I had a fall last winter, and I learned black ice is invisible, not black. Pride and backside got bruised, humbling indeed. I considered it a one-off event. Nonetheless, I don't want falling to be a part of my life.

I was so glad to see that the class "A Matter of Balance" was offered again this fall. I signed up and expected to learn a few ways to "fall-proof" my home and get safety tips to avoid falls. What I found was a whole new way to look at the problem of falling. I learned that even my own fear of falling and traumatic feelings about falls actually increased my personal risk of falling. I had more risk factors than I thought. Turns out age wasn't even my most concerning risk factor.

The balance class leaders, a Physical Therapist and specially trained fall prevention instructor, take participants through a comprehensive look at the mental, physical, environmental, and functional factors that affect falling. We then explore ways to change our risks, improve our strength and balance, and enhance confidence in our ability to prevent falls. The instructors are

knowledgeable, class activities are practical, and simple exercises are used to increase balance. I am very impressed with this program and recommend it because anyone can fall. This class is fun, easy, informative, worthwhile, and free! It's possible that **your** biggest risk factor for falls is thinking **you** don't need to take this class. Thank you, Sue and Beaver Valley Lutheran Church, for hosting and promoting this class.

Simple Guide: Your New Online Member Directory Login





The Online Member Directory app update

To prepare for the new system, all users will have to set up a new way to log in.

VERY IMPORTANT FIRST STEP

Your old username and password will **NOT WORK** in the new system. All users must now log in with an **email address** and set up a **brand new password**.

Please follow these steps in order. Only move to the next step if the current step fails.

Step 1: Reset Your Password

If your existing account was successfully moved over, this is the quickest way to get started.

- 1. Go to the app.onlinememberdirectory.com on the website or the new app.
- 2. On the third page, click "Forgot Password" or try here under the login fields.
- 3. Enter your email address, the one listed on your directory profile.
- 4. Check your email for a verification code email. (if you do not get an email with a code check your email for typos.)
- 5. Enter the verification code and set up your new password.

If you get an **error message that your account cannot be found** after resetting your password, please move on to Step 2.

Step 2: Create a New Account (Sign Up with Email)

If Step 1 did not work, it means the system couldn't find your account. Next, create a new account with your email.

- 1. Go to <u>app.olinememberdirectory.com</u>, under the login button click "Dont have an account, sign up by **email.**"
- 2. Enter your email address to create your new account.
- 3. Enter your code and setup your new login credentials.
- 4. The system will automatically try to match your new account with your existing membership using your name and email.

If it matches, you will be all set!

If you receive an error, please move on to Step 3 to try signing up with your phone number.

Step 3: Try Signing Up With Your Phone Number

If signing up with your email in Step 2 did not connect you to your membership, your directory record might only have your mobile phone number on file. Try this step next.

- 1. On the <u>app.onlinememberdirectory.com</u> screen, click Phone next to "dont have an account yet?"
- 2. This time, enter your mobile phone number instead of your email address to sign up.
- 3. You will recieve a text with a code. Enter your code and login.
- 4. The system will automatically try to match your account.
 - o If your mobile phone number and name match an existing membership you'll be all set.
 - If this Sign Up process also tells you it cannot find your existing membership,
 please move on to Step 4.

Step 4: Use the Invite Code to Join the Directory

This step is only needed if all other attempts (Steps 1, 2, and 3) failed to connect you to your existing membership record.

- 1. If the Sign Up process fails to match you, the system may ask you to "Join Existing Directory" or "Start a new Directory"
- 2. You must get the Invite Code from your local organization. Please contact your church or organization directory admin leader directly for this code. (Due to high call volumes and for faster results, contact your specific admin(s) first before you contact the main Online Member Directory support team.) Enter the code here.

Once the code is entered, an administrator will likely need to approve the connection. This may take a little time, but your account will be fixed!
