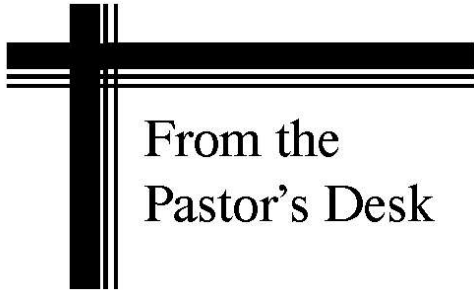



- (boiler, electrical, etc.) will now require a licensed, insured, bonded contractor to do the work.
- **Limit Security Access to the Church-**For security reasons, the security code will be changed on the office entrance door. All doors to the church will now be keyed the same.
- **Fellowship Rentals – Verbiage** will be updated for facilities use information for non-members. Susan Kruse will work on this.
- **Advertising in the Garretson Gazette –** Dena from the Garretson Gazette called to see if we were interested in running an ad in their special edition for Jesse James Days, June 19th – June 21st. She said she was contacting people who had run ads in the past. She described the ad they had copy for, and it would need to be updated with current information. This would not increase the cost of the ad. The cost of the ad would be \$81.00. – It was decided that for now, our advertising focus would be directed toward our Website and Facebook Posts on Community pages. We will also be handing out Postcards in area parades that will highlight Beaver Valley Lutheran Church and all the great things we have going on.
- **VBS advertising in the Brandon Valley Journal and Trader.** A 3x6 ad is \$225, a 2x5 is \$145, or a 3x3 is \$125. Previously, we have run a 3x3 ad for 3 weeks. If we wanted to run it for 4 weeks, the per-week cost would drop to \$110. - It was decided that for now, our advertising focus would be directed toward our Website and Facebook Posts on Community pages. We will also be handing out Postcards in area parades that will highlight Beaver Valley Lutheran Church and all the great things we have going on.
- **Kitchen Organization-** A small group of women will be cleaning and organizing the kitchen in the next few weeks. Krista Hanson will organize this.
- **Church Events (June through Oct 11) –** Many events are being planned for the summer. Please keep an eye on the Tidings and church calendar for details.
- **A discussion was held about creating a visitor’s table with welcome bags and church information.** Sara Kiefer, along with Pastor Josh, will work on this project.
- **Legacy Music Wall-** Susan Kruse made a motion to allow the legacy committee to move forward with their music wall project. Seconded by David Vanden Hull. Motion passed.
- **Pastoral Care Discussion-**How do we make sure that people/congregation members are taken care of? Lay care? Pastoral care online form? Intake form if one would like a visit? Anyone wanting a visit should let the pastor or the church office know.

- David purchased the computer hardware to run the digital sign displays in the lower hallway and upper greeting area. Plan for digital sign management and setup attached.

- Personnel met with Pastor Josh to discuss ongoing pastoral care requirements/needs and looked at making the process easier for care requests.
- Met with Jacqui Shoemaker for her annual review.
- Contacted Midwest Ledgers about payroll adjustments that never were made after the annual meeting, along with getting Pastor Josh's June pay raise implemented.

- Dave S finished replacing the north-west door and frame of the sanctuary. The door is keyed the same as all other outside doors. The water softener installation is completed and is working properly. Olsen Pest Control is in the process of planning to address the "black" sealant issue. Scott spoke with them on 5-12-26. They apologized, stating that it is not the quality of work they do. They will be making it right with us. The parking lot advisory group asked for approval from the property committee to have an electrician install 4 light poles in the parking lot. Property will update the new LED light bulbs in the light poles already present on the south side of the church.

- Taking ideas for fall events and speakers now. We might want to consider doing a congregational survey on interests. It is unsettling to have no signups for planned events. Maybe new ideas for events and speakers can be found.

SPRING HAS SPRUNG!!

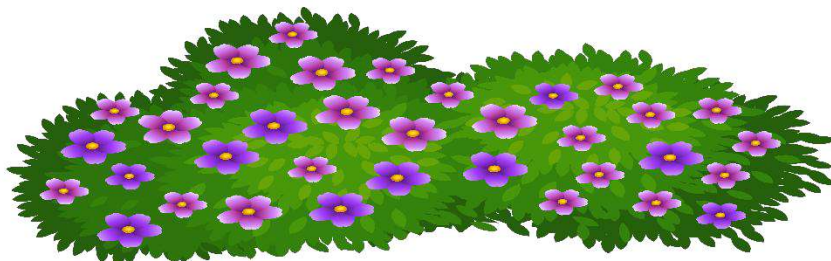
The Outdoor Committee – We might have a short-lived spring, but the Outdoor Committee has been hard at work getting some updates done to the Prayer Garden.

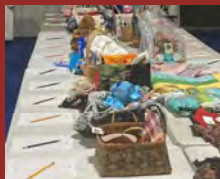

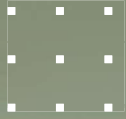
