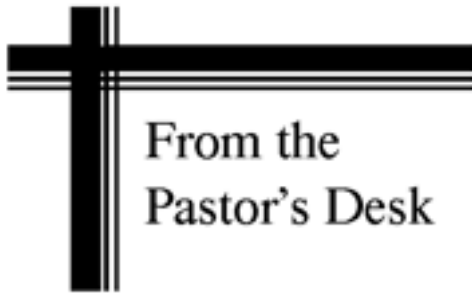

Friends in Christ,

Greetings to each and every one of you from God, our loving heavenly Father, and our living Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. I hope and pray that this article finds all of you well, as we come to the end of our first program year together.

As we end this program year, I want to start by saying thank you to all of you for being willing to try new things. When I arrived at Beaver Valley, I told you that I do Confirmation a little differently. Instead of just having the kids read a book or listen to a lecture for a full 60 minutes, I try to break their evenings down. I give them 30 minutes of lecture, and they spend the next 30 minutes doing a project. This year, the students have done projects ranging from posters to working with clay to making short videos to learn the material in Luther's Small Catechism. This style of Confirmation instruction seems to help the students get a better grasp of the material, and it also helps them to memorize the main ideas.

I also want to express my appreciation for the small group leaders of the Confirmation students. They have been willing to be very important parts of this Confirmation program. Without them, Confirmation instruction is not possible. They have been with our students almost every Wednesday night since September, and they have all had profound impacts on the young people in our family of faith.

In addition to showing appreciation in the Confirmation program, I also want to thank the people who are involved in other areas of youth ministry. Brittany and Alan have been instrumental in working with our younger members and with our high school youth. They have been willing to share their time, energy, and talents with many young people in this family of faith.

Whenever I take the time to thank the people who give of their time and talents to allow for great youth ministry to happen, I also thank the people who share their financial resources. The members of Beaver Valley Lutheran Church have been very supportive of this program this year. You have shared monetary and in-kind donations. You have brought soups and dishes for Advent dinners and Lent potlucks (weren't those fun?). You have also had many conversations with the kids in this congregation. I want to let you know that your kindness and support are greatly appreciated!

Along with youth ministry, we have offered many other programs this year. We have had Bible studies, first aid and CPR classes, sourdough instruction, lefse making, babysitting classes, grief class, balance class, and other great opportunities. I want to thank everyone who has taken part in these educational opportunities. It is always fun to see people together learning something new and joining in meaningful conversations. It has been an exciting and busy program year at Beaver Valley Lutheran Church!

If you know of a program that you would like to see offered in our family of faith, please let me know. If you would like to lead a program at our church, that would be amazing! We are always looking for ways for our members to connect to one another, connect to our community, and to grow closer to our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

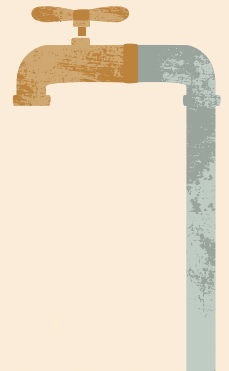
