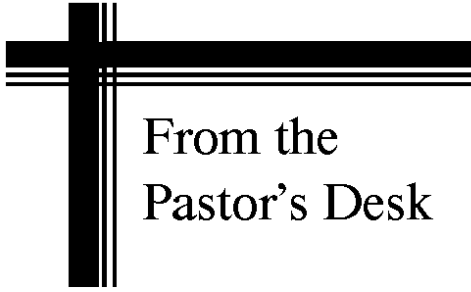

Old Business:

- **Review and Approve Facility Use Update - A few changes were made to the Facilities Use Information Part 1 (non-members will now pay \$25 for a kitchen service assistant and Part 2 (all are expected to furnish their own paper products, and no exterior doors are to be propped open). Susan Kruse presented the updates to the council. Motion to accept these changes made by Amy Johnson and seconded by Dan Feeken. Motion carried.**
- **Estimated time of completion for choir room shelving and register covers in the basement - Alan Schmidt is going to work on the shelving, and the register covers are to be done late in July by Josh Dede and Scott Hansel.**
- **Status of the range in the kitchen that is not working - Suggested that someone on the property committee reach out to the company that did the installation/inspection of the stove.**

New Business:

- **Security Report - Pastor Josh met with Rick Miller from Homeland Security to discuss security issues and vulnerabilities around the church. Some things that were discussed were: intercoms/walkie-talkies, locking doors, a fence around the heating/cooling unit, cement pylons around the electrical unit, a map of the church for the fire dept, etc.**
- **Budget - a lengthy discussion was held about the current state of our general fund. At present, the expenses are exceeding the income. It was decided that we would have to use money from the**

undesigned memorials account if it becomes necessary. The Stewardship committee will be working on a plan of action.

- Insurance for special events - Brittany Gerovac checked with our insurance carrier. All our current policy covers events /activities held on the church grounds.
- Staff appreciation will be held on June 28· Cake will be served.
- Non-profit status - BVLC is a 501C3.
- Welcome bags – Sara Kiefer has put together welcome bags for visitors to BVLC. The cost for the bags is \$3.26 each. A donation covered the initial 25 bags.

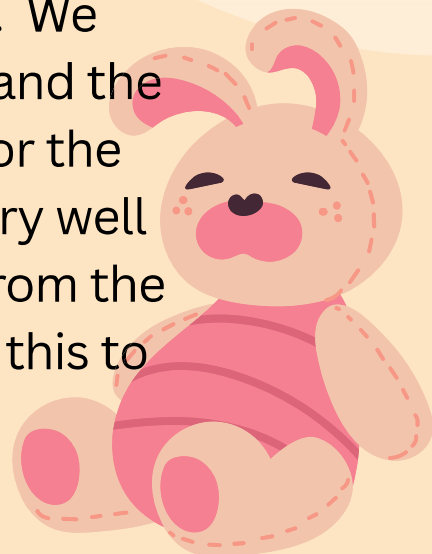
