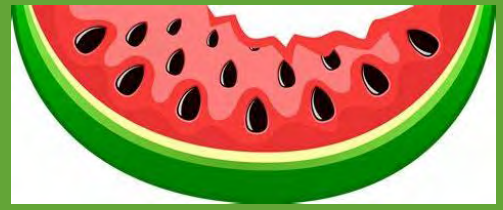

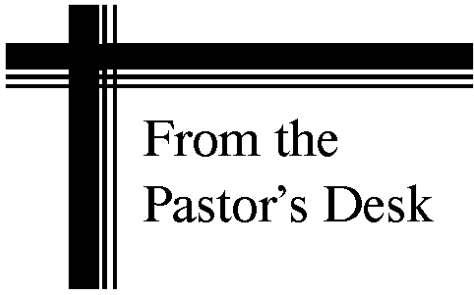

From the Pastor's Desk

Friends in Christ,

Greetings to each and every one of you from God our loving heavenly Father and our living Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. I hope and pray that this newsletter finds all of you well now that we are in the home stretch of the summer! I am not really sure where

June and July went. This time of the year always goes so fast.

Not too long ago, I gave a sermon on giving regularly. During that sermon, I discussed the importance of being willing to share the gifts God has given to us back to God to do God's work. It was a fun sermon to give because stewardship is one of my favorite topics (along with Evangelism, worship, youth ministry, etc.). As I preached, I talked about making an inventory of all of your talents and abilities and finding a way to share 10 percent of what you are good at with the congregation, so we can do ministry together.

As the week progressed after that sermon, I realized that we are not only invited to make inventories of our own talents. We are also invited to talk to other people about their gifts, talents, and abilities. We should be willing to help them see ways that they have been endowed with passions and things they are very effective at doing. After I gave that sermon, I came into contact with someone who had a great passion for something. She and I had a brief conversation about things she enjoyed doing, and we talked about where she went to college and her major. While we were talking, I listened to her because that is what she needed in the moment. Then, I also thought about ways that I could connect her with someone that I have gotten to know quite well. When my conversation came to an end, I asked her if I could make the connection for her because my friend has an opportunity for her to use her passions to make a real difference in the world. I had her permission, so the connection was made. I am not sure where it will lead, but I know that this person now has a new connection that could help her succeed and do some real work on behalf of the God we love and praise! I am praying for her and her new connection, along with my friend, to see if his need can be met, and she can do what she is called to do!

Who is someone in your life for whom you could make this connection? Maybe it is someone you already know. There is someone God has placed in your current path that is looking for someone to help them identify their gift and passions. You are the one who will get to help them name what they are good at, and you get to help them see what they love to do. Perhaps you have not met this person yet. In the days, weeks, months, or years ahead, God will place someone in your life who needs someone like you to make a connection for them. When that moment comes, you get to be a part of someone finding the right place to plug in and do the work God has empowered them and called them to do. That moment will be awesome!

Approval of Treasurer's Report:

**MMSC: Motion to approve the June treasurer's report made by Kelly Wright and seconded by Susan Kruse.
Motion carried.**

Old Business:

- **Status of the range in the kitchen that is not working** – Dave Schnabel spoke with someone who instructed him on how to resolve the issue. The range is now operating correctly.
- **Estimated time of completion for choir room shelving** – August
- **Status of register covers in the basement** – Dave Schnabel has been working on this. He has removed the old registers and repaired and repainted the walls. Everything should be on track for Scott Hansel and Josh Dede to get the register covers reinstalled on July 25th.
- **Non-profit/Tax Exempt status** - BVLC is a 501C3 for non-profit status, and because of this, we are considered Tax Exempt on the Federal level, but the state of SD does not consider Religious Organizations as tax exempt. Going forward, companies like Ban-Koe will be charging us tax for services rendered.

New Business:

- A thorough discussion was held about the state of our General Operating Fund bank account. The general account is where all bills (payroll, electric, etc.) are paid from. Offerings and giving into our general fund are not keeping up with the expenses that we currently have. It is low enough that we need to transfer money from the Memorial Saving(undesignated) account. A motion to move money from the Memorial Savings (undesignated) to the general fund as needed was made by David

Vanden Hull and seconded by Sara Kiefer. Motion passed. The stewardship committee is working on temple talks for Sunday mornings this fall. Letters will be sent out with quarter-end statements.

- Susan Kruse made a motion to pay out all remaining investment certificates from Tornado Savings. The savings will then be closed at the end of 2026. Seconded by David Vanden Hull. Motion passed.
- Brandon Valley Journal & Trader - Wanted to see if we were interested in their Blanket Issue, which is delivered to over 11,700 mailboxes and offers a great opportunity to reach a large local audience with broad community exposure. NuRev (David VandenHull) will donate a 6 X 10.5 advertisement in the journal. A motion was made by Amy Johnson to buy a 2 x 5 ad for \$135 for the Women in Business segment of the Brandon Valley Journal. Seconded by Josh Dede. Motion passed.
- Motion to approve Steve Ring as an interim council member was made by David VandenHull and seconded by Amy Johnson. Motion passed.
